

AUDITION FORM

Please arrive for auditions promptly at 2:00 pm.

(If you want to participate but cannot make the Sunday audition, please contact us and we might be able to arrange for an alternative audition.)

Audition process:

- Sign in procedure – you'll sign in & be given an audition # to pin to your shirt. You'll get your photo taken. You'll turn in your completed audition form and be given an audition packet.
- Welcome notes from the director.
- We will have a warm up and then some group/small group activities (these are considered part of the audition process)
- For non-musicals:
 - ✓ You will perform your 1 min. monologue.
 - ✓ You will be given short scenes to prepare.
- For musicals:
 - ✓ Everyone will be taught a short piece from one of the show's songs. You will audition the song in small groups.
 - ✓ Everyone will be taught a short piece of choreography. You will audition the choreography in small groups.
 - ✓ Those wanting to be considered for a feature role (small ensemble or lead) will sing their prepared 30 sec. - 1 min piece.
- You will prepare/present some short scenes (create in small group and/or from prepared script).
- Final questions and then you may leave.

Casting will be posted on the website www.actingout.info by the following Sunday. You will be notified by email if there will be call-backs on Thursday.
